My autoupdater options are the same as in your picture, and I've jus did a reinstalation but the problem remains.

Also, I've just registered a new user in lobby, whit a new passowrd and a new email adress, and registration is successfull, but when I try to login with this new username I get the same invalid username/password message.

My host file in windows/sytem32/drivers/etc seems ok, the content is this:
