But you are wrong in saying that he had a parallel acceleration possibilty. You hit and upset his car and balance so he can never come back on speed . You should have waited with attack after next corner, this way just isn't fair. Unbalance another car and then pass him is wrong.

Hi byagm,

well, to be honest I got nothing specific to mention. The reason why I replied so soon to Schwiizers Post was simply this: he reacted very upset in TS and disappeared from the race and from TS. Due to the fact that my race was already over (I crashed by own fault), I had time to check forum and did see his posting. I was afraid that he could really leave ABB, so I wrote what I heard in TS after the race (without mentioning names, or "who said what"). I did see that he was still online on the website, so I hoped he would see my reply/answer and he would notice that we already discuss the incident, what should (watching/analyze Replays, notify the Admins etc.) and could (from writing PM-admonition/-warning up to a penalty/exclusion for maybe 2 weeks).

So my opinion was at least to calm him a bit down and to ensure him, that we immediately tried to find possible solutions.

But now back to your question: Look, I am one of the rather slow drivers here on the ABB, due to the fact that I have a huge lack of track-knowledge. So for me it takes a lot longer to become quick on a track, because the most of them are completely new for me. During the Test-Session I can hardly concentrate on learning the racing-line, brake-points etc. because most of the time I have to watch into the mirrors.

In the last few months I had plenty of chances to notice the common-behaviors of most of the ABB-drivers. Some are patient, some are very ambitious, other ones try to help and guide for one or two laps, some are rather selfish and others just want to have some relaxing fun together.

And most of the ABB-drivers know my Driving-Style now too: whenever I see someone gaining from behind, I'll do my very best to get out of the way, sometimes even leave the track and risk to lose the car, just to avoid ruining his lap! So most of the other drivers know, that if I don't leave the racing-line it's very likely that I haven't seen him yet or it's too risky for both if I'd change my line. For me (as for most of us) it's a nice and well proven behaviour to flash the headlights when we let another pass, so he will be assured, that he can take his line without risking a crash. Sometimes this manoeuvre has to wait two or three corners, there is no need to push like hell.

Well, what poRacer wrote is true (from our point of "Backmarkers"-View), but all in all I think that the very most of our drivers here are really fair and I really enjoy driving and racing with all of you!
